WHAT WILL WE LEARN THIS TERM?

MATHS

GEOMETRY - POSITION

We will learn:

- To describe position, direction and movement, including whole, half, quarter and three-quarter turns.

PLACE VALUE TO 100

We will learn:

- To count to 100, forwards and backwards.
- To count, read and write numbers to 100 in numerals.

MONEY

We will learn:

- To recognise the value of different coins and notes.

TIME

We will learn:

- To use language relating to dates, like days of the week, weeks, months and years.
- To tell the time to the hour, half past the hour and draw the hands on a clock.

ENGLISH

POETRY: TRADITIONAL POEMS

We will listen to traditional action rhymes, rounds, songs and nursery rhymes. We will explore verbs and sentence punctuation and improvise dramas based on nursery rhymes.

FICTION: MODERN FICTION: ED VERE STORIES

We will read books by Ed Vere and write character profiles and sequence narratives.



SCIENCE

EVERYDAY MATERIALS

- Distinguish between an object and the material it is made from.
- Identify and name a variety of everyday materials, including wood, plastic, glass, metal, water, and rock.
- Describe the properties of a variety of everyday materials.
- Compare and group together a variety of everyday materials on the basis of their simple physical properties.



HISTORY

TRAVEL AND TRANSPORT

In this topic, we will be looking at the history of transport. We will take a look at how key transport such as cars and aeroplanes have changed.

We will create our own bunting using different materials. We will also discover the different methods of sewing to see what we can use for our bunting.
