Overview of Fees

FEE TYPE	DETAILS	AMOUNT	PAYABLE BY
PRE-ENTRY ASSESSMENT FEE	Covers the cost of initial assessments such as cognitive ability, reading, subject knowledge & interviews. It is a one-off, non-refundable fee payable even if the child is not selected.	£50.00	For new applicants only: Due when being invited for the initial assessment.
ADMISSION FEE	A one-off, non-refundable payment after a place is offered at the Academy to confirm the place.	£130.00	For new applicants only: Due when completing the admissions procedure.
ANNUAL RESOURCE FEE	Covers the cost of extra materials like handouts, photocopies, selected workbooks, exercise books, general art supplies and digital resources etc. The fee is non-refundable.	£120.00	New applicants: Due when completing the admissions procedure. Existing pupils: In the last term prior to the academic year. Communications will be sent out with a due date.
ANNUAL SCHOOL FEE	Covers the cost of the National Curriculum, Madrasah Syllabus, and any Hifz al-Qur'an or Alimiyyah Programmes the pupil may be enrolled in at the Academy.	Primary £2,400.00* Secondary £2,580.00*	Payable in full on 3 rd of August annually or Years 1 to 10: Monthly Standing Order from 3 rd August to 3 rd July (12 months). Year 11: Monthly Standing Order from 3 rd August to 3 rd May (10 months).
EXAM FEES	These are payable by parents for GCSE Exam Entries per subject.	Variable	For GCSE pupils: Parents will be provided dates and amounts for exam fees.

This excludes additional payments that may be required during the year. For example, Trips, Additional Educational Activities etc.

*There is currently no VAT on school fees. If a government was to change this policy, VAT would be payable on top pro-rata, even if in mid-year.
