

WHAT WILL WE LEARN THIS TERM?

- will compare and sequence intervals of time
- We will tell and write the time to five minutes, including quarter past/to the hour and draw the hands on a clock face to show these times
- We will learn the number of minutes in an hour and the number of hours in a day

- We will interpret and construct simple pictograms. tally charts, block diagrams and simple tables
- We will ask and answer simple questions by counting the number of objects in each category and sorting the categories by quantity
- We will ask and answer questions about totalling and comparing categorical data

- We will order and arrange combinations of mathematical objects in patterns and sequences
- We will use mathematical vocabulary to describe position, direction and movement, including movement in a straight line
- We will begin to distinguish between rotation as a turn and in terms of right angles for quarter, half and threequarter turns (clockwise and anticlockwise)

ENGLISH

POETRY: HAPPY POEMS

Using 'McGough's Happy Poems', we will read and write poems about pets, treasures and magic pebbles.

NON-FICTION: READING AND WRITING RECOUNTS

Children will be inspired to write creative recounts by reading great imaginative texts, including 'The Velveteen Rabbit'. We will focus on grammar including subordinate clauses, present and past progressive verbs.



CIENCE MATERIALS

We will:

- Identify and compare the suitability of a variety of everyday materials, including wood, metal, plastic, glass, brick, rock, paper and cardboard for
- particular uses.
 Find out how the shapes of solid objects made from some materials can be changed by squashing, bending, twisting and stretching.

HISTORY

TRAVEL AND TRANSPORT

In this topic, we will be looking at, the history of transport. We will take a look at how key transport such at cars and aeroplanes have changed.

FABRIC BUNTING

We will create our own bunting using different materials. We will also discover the different methods of sewing to see what we can sew for our bunting.
