MATERIALS MATTER

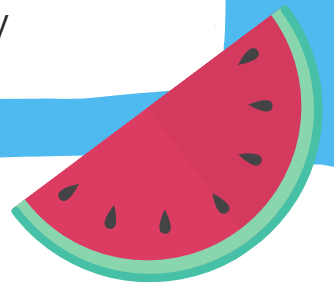

WHAT WILL WE LEARN THIS TERM?

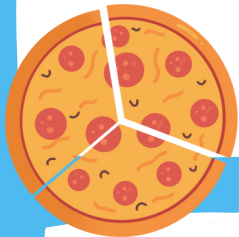
MATHS FRACTIONS

1/3

- We will recognise, find, name and write fractions, $1/3$, $1/4$, $2/4$, and $3/4$ of a length, shape, set of objects or quantity
- We will write simple fractions, for example of $1/2$ of $6 = 3$ and recognise the equivalence of $2/4$ and $1/2$.

TIME

- We will compare and sequence intervals of time
- We will tell and write the time to five minutes, including quarter past/to the hour and draw the hands on a clock face to show these times
- We will learn the number of minutes in an hour and the number of hours in a day



GEOGRAPHY

OUR COUNTRY

In this topic of learning, we will be looking at the UK. We will begin to identify key landmarks, what the UK is and how it compares to other countries like Brazil.



PE

ATTACK, DEFEND, SHOOT

In PE, we will learn how to use space, defending and methods to help you pass a ball.



COMPUTING

ARABIC



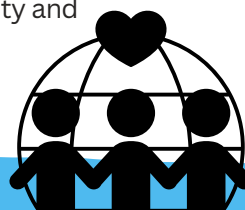
We will learn how to write letters laam to hamza.

RESPONSIBILITY AND THE COMMUNITY

In PSHE, we will learn about what community means. We will look at what makes a community and how to be good to our community.



ENGLISH

POETRY: HAPPY POEMS

Using 'McGough's Happy Poems', we will read and write poems about pets, treasures and magic pebbles.



NON-FICTION: READING AND WRITING RECOUNTS

Children will be inspired to write creative recounts by reading great imaginative texts, including 'The Velveteen Rabbit'. We will focus on grammar including subordinate clauses, present and past progressive verbs.



SCIENCE MATERIALS

We will:

- Identify and compare the suitability of a variety of everyday materials, including wood, metal, plastic, glass, brick, rock, paper and cardboard for particular uses.
- Find out how the shapes of solid objects made from some materials can be changed by squashing, bending, twisting and stretching.

FABRICATE

We will create masterpieces using many different techniques. We will be using 3D materials such as beads and designing coasters.

We will be learning about what tayammum is and how to perform it.

AHADITH

We will be learning about what the Prophet SAW said regarding kindness to animals.
