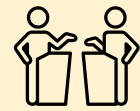
GEOGRAPHY

RAGING RIVERS

In this unit, we will find out about why rivers are so important to the towns and villages that have developed on their banks. By looking at the features of rivers, and the natural and human ways that rivers change over time, we will explore the life stories of rivers. We will learn the names and locations of the major rivers of the UK and the world.



ENGLISH



NON-FICTION: ARGUMENT AND DEBATE - CONTINUED

School uniform, detentions, mobile phones or screen time - there's always an argument! In this block of learning, we will learn the skills for effective argument and persuasion, both written and spoken. For grammar, we will explore cohesion, paragraphs and commas.

FICTION: SHORT STORIES: SPOOKY SHORT STORIES

SPOOKY

Study genre of short stories using Short! by Crossley-Holland. Investigate adverbials and develop use of perfect form to indicate time/cause. Write predictions and short stories.

SCIENCE

PROPERTIES AND CHANGES OF MATERIALS

This unit will teach us about different materials, their uses and their properties, as well as dissolving, separating mixtures and irreversible changes. We will sort and classify objects according to their properties. We will work in a hands-on way to explore dissolving and will find out about different ways to separate mixtures of materials, using filtering, sieving and evaporating. Finally, we will learn about irreversible changes.



COMPUTING

LEAFLET DESIGN

In computing, pupils will be researching, planning and designing a leaflet about a scientist. They will learn new formatting, digital design and research skills, which they will use in their final piece.

PE BASKETBALL



This Basketball unit will teach us the skills players need to play both defensively and offensively. We will learn how to dribble and pass the ball using a range of different techniques. We will also learn some of the rules of the game and to play as part of a team in a mini-tournament, putting our newly developed skills into practise.

ARABIC

FAMILIES



This term in Arabic, we will be talking about our families. We will learn how to describe their appearance and revisit some old vocabulary too. This will include their general appearance such as tall, short. As well as facial descriptions such as colour of eyes, hair, etc.

MARBLELOUS STRUCTURES

This Marbulous Structures unit will give us the opportunity to develop our understanding of more complex free standing structures and how they can be strengthened and reinforced.

We will gain knowledge and understanding about how to join and shape materials and then apply these skills to create our marble runs. Finally, we will test and evaluate our marble runs against design criteria.



PSHE MONEY (CONTINUED)



In this unit, we will learn about how money is used in the wider world. We will discuss what a financial risk is, why people may take risks with money and some consequences of this. We will explore how to see the real value of products by being critical consumers and also consider influences that advertisers try to use to encourage people to spend money. Having learnt about ways we can spend money, we will also learn about budgeting and will discuss how people may choose or need to prioritise spending. Throughout the unit, we will have an opportunity to discuss what impact money can have on people's emotional wellbeing. We will consider the emotions that can be experienced around money and discuss the fact that people cannot always afford what they want or what they need, as well as the impact this may have on emotional wellbeing. We will also explore the impact of spending on the environment by discussing how earning and spending can contribute to society (through the payment of tax) and also the decisions people may choose to make around ethical spending by discussing issues like fair trade, single-use plastics and recycling.
