



JGA Admissions Procedure

Jameah Girls Academy is an independent day school for girls in Years 1-11. We are a small school with single form entry, and places in each Year group are limited. We appreciate that choosing the right school for your child is very important, therefore we encourage you to explore our website and you may email or ring the school for more information. We hold an Open Day in the Spring Term which gives a general introduction to the school.

We base our selection process on our principal criteria which is whether the pupil will thrive in a competitive, but tolerant and friendly environment, and whether she will access the curriculum on offer. This will be assessed at Stage 1, 2 and 3 of the Admissions process.

The aim of the process is to identify potential. Jameah Girls Academy is looking for well-rounded pupils with a genuine interest in education in the broadest sense of the word, with interests that stretch beyond the the academic curriculum and we look for pupils who are keen to take advantage of either the Hifdh or 'Alimiyyah options on offer.

Please Note:

- Applications for Year 6 and Year 7 are usually oversubscribed, and we recommend that applications for school places are made as early as Key Stage 1 to avoid disappointment. Early entry to the school carries the additional advantage of your daughter learning the Arabic language from an early age.
- We only accept application for Year 9 for the start of that academic year. There are no in-year applications.
- We do not accept new applications for pupils in Year 10 and 11.

The Stages are outlined below:

Stage 1: Application Form

JGA must receive a fully completed form with the latest school report and other requested documents. Apply at:

Admissions are kept on file until an Admissions window is opened for in-year applications dependent on availability of space, therefore, there is no fixed time for when an Admissions window may be opened for an in-year application.

Applications for a new academic year are considered from the Spring Term.



Stage 2: Admissions Test

Applications which pass Stage 1 of the Procedure will be invited to an Admissions test. This is an online test that yields a standardised age score for key areas of learning. There is a non-refundable fee of £30 for the test. The test is not the guarantee of a place offer, nor does it commit you to joining the school.



Stage 3: Interview

Applications that progress to Stage 3 will be invited for an in-person pupil and parent interview with a member of the school leadership team. The interview gives us the opportunity to discuss your daughter's performance in the assessment and assess her academic potential and personal interests.



Stage 4: Outcome

Applicants will be informed if the school is able to offer the applicant a place or not.

Please Note:

- Unfortunately, we cannot guarantee that all applications will progress through every stage of the process. Progression at each stage is subject to certain criteria and availability.
- At Stage 2 or 3, an application may be placed on a waiting list.
- Only applications that are offered a place at Stage 4 will have the opportunity to accept the place. The place offer will contain a start date which must be accepted within 10 days of receipt.

The parents of successful candidates are sent a copy of the Terms and Conditions for Jameah Girls Academy and the Parents' Handbook. New admissions are required to sign the Acceptance Form and pay a non-refundable Admission fee of £100 and a resource fee of £100 – payable before the pupil starts at the school. A standing order mandate must be set up prior to the start date to ensure regular payment of fees over the academic year. Fees will be calculated from the pupil's start date.
