WHAT WILL WE LEARN THIS TERM?

MATHS

MULTIPLICATION AND DIVISIONS

- Write and calculate mathematical statements
- Using mental and formal written methods
- Recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 2,3,4,5,8 and 10.

LENGTH AND PERIMETER

- Measure, compare, add and subtract: lengths (m/cm/mm); mass (kg/g); volume/capacity (l/ml)
- Measure the perimeter of simple 2-D shapes

FRACTIONS

- Recognise, find and write fractions of a discrete set of objects: unit fractions and non-unit fractions with small denominators
- Compare and order unit fractions, and fractions with the same denominators
- Recognise and show, using diagrams, equivalent fractions with small denominators

ENGLISH

FICTION - FANTASTIC MR FOX

Through Roald Dahl's Fantastic Mr Fox, children explore plot, character and tension. They learn about direct speech and tense, and write their own exciting stories.

NON-FICTION- THE INK GARDEN OF BROTHER THEOPHANE

Inspire writing in this hands-on block with the beautiful Ink Garden of Brother Theophane, learn about illuminated manuscripts and making dyes. Study conjunctions and prepositions.

PLANTS

- Explore the requirements of plants for life and growth (air, light, water, nutrients from soil, and room to grow) and how they vary from plant to plant.
- Identify and describe the functions of different parts of flowering plants: roots, stem/trunk, leaves and flowers.
- Investigate the way in which water is transported within plants.
- Record findings using simple scientific language, drawings, labelled diagrams, keys, bar charts, and tables.
- Make systematic and careful observations and, where appropriate, take accurate measurements using standard units.

SCIENCE

GEOGRAPHY

Within this topic, we will learn and understand the different key aspects of physical geography in the context of volcanoes. We will identify how volcanoes are formed and how these physical features have an affect on people's lives.

VOLCANOES

ART FRUIT AND VEGETABLES

This 'Fruit and Vegetables' art topic will teach us about how to use pencil, colour, paint, clay fruit or vegetables and textiles to create quality art work that shows progression in their skills. The children will also have the opportunity to explore the work of the designer, Carl Warner, textile artist, Michael Brennand-Wood and Italian painter, Caravaggio

PE

In PE, this term we will have a specialist tutor coming in to deliver exciting P.E lessons. We will be covering a wide range of sports including outdoor activities such as tennis, hockey and more. This will provide us with a wide range of different techniques and skills.

COMPUTING BRANCHING DATABASES/ PHOTO EDITING

In this term, we will continue learning about branching databases. We will then develop an understanding on how digital images can be changed and edited, and how it can then be resaved and reused. We will consider the impact that editing images can have, and evaluate the effectiveness of our choices.
