

NON-FICTION - ARGUMENT AND DEBATE



POETRY: POEMS BY THE SAME POET - JOSEPH COELHO

We will read and write powerful poems about the sea and the Titanic, including Hardy's Convergence of the Twain. For grammar, we will revise word classes, noun phrases and adverbials. Start with the core unit to introduce key texts.

SCIENCE

ANIMALS INCLUDING HUMANS

This unit focuses on the changes that human beings experience as they develop to old age. We will learn about the life cycle of a human being and will investigate the development of babies and compare the gestation period of humans and other animals. We will learn about the changes experienced during puberty and why these occur. The final investigation will be about comparing the life expectancy of different animals.



COMPUTING

SCRATCH PROGRAMMING

This unit explores the concept of repetition in programming using the Scratch environment. We will look at the difference between count-controlled and infinite loops, and use our knowledge to modify existing animations and games using repetition. Our final project is to design and create a game which uses repetition, applying stages of programming design throughout.



SPORTS AND WEATHER

As we start welcoming the warmer days of summer, this term we will be focussing on sports and weather as well as bringing in prior knowledge of hobbies. You will learn to say longer sentences. Do you like playing football in the park on a summers' day? Let's say it in Arabic!

PE BASKETBALL

This Basketball unit will teach us the skills players need to play both defensively and offensively. We will learn how to dribble and pass the ball using a range of different techniques. We will also learn some of the rules of the game and to play as part of a team in a mini-tournament, putting our newly developed skills into practise.

SEASONAL COOKING

This 'Super Seasonal Cooking' unit of work will teach us about the importance of buying seasonal food. We will learn where, when and how a variety of ingredients are grown, reared, caught and processed. We will then sample some spring seasonal food before designing our own balanced seasonal meal.

Transporting ourselves to the Haramain, we will be learning the method of performing Umrah, and understanding the definition of some key words such as; Ihram, Talbiyah, Meeqaat, and Istilaam.

PSHE MONEY



In this unit, we will learn about how money is used in the wider world. We will discuss what a financial risk is, why people may take risks with money and some consequences of this. We will explore how to see the real value of products by being critical consumers and also consider influences that advertisers try to use to encourage people to spend money. Having learnt about ways we can spend money, we will also learn about budgeting and will discuss how people may choose or need to prioritise spending. Throughout the unit, we will have an opportunity to discuss what impact money can have on people's emotional wellbeing. We will consider the emotions that can be experienced around money and discuss the fact that people cannot always afford what they want or what they need, as well as the impact this may have on emotional wellbeing. We will also explore the impact of spending on the environment by discussing how earning and spending can contribute to society (through the payment of tax) and also the decisions people may choose to make around ethical spending by discussing issues like fair trade, single-use plastics and recycling.
