
Year 6, it's time to start looking ahead and thinking of the future.

What will we learn this term?

MATHS

STATISTICS

- We will draw, read and interpret complex graphs.
- We will read off approximate values for data that lies between two marked points.
- We will infer what has happened in a given situation based on the information provided in the line graph.
- We will recognise the importance of a key to ensure that the bar charts can be interpreted.
- We will construct pie charts using a protractor.
- We will calculate and interpret the mean as an average.

POSITION & DIRECTION

- We will describe positions on the full coordinate grid, including all four quadrants.
- We will draw and translate simple shapes on the coordinate plane, and reflect them in the axes.





COMPUTING

DIGITAL DESIGN

In computing, pupils will be researching, planning and designing a presentation about famous scientists they are learning about in science. They will learn new formatting, animating and presentation skills, which they will use in their final piece.

HISTORY

THE INDUS VALLEY CIVILISATION

In History, we will be learning about the early civilisation of the Indus Valley. We will be locating where in the world it existed and learn about the key people who led the discovery of the Indus Valley civilisation. We will also learn about different aspects of life during the Ancient Indus Valley civilisation, including what it was like to live in a city and what clothes and jewellery the people wore.

CREATE AND MAKE

In D&T, we will be designing and creating a variety of things, including shoes and many more interesting and exciting items. We will then evaluate our wonderful creations at the end to conclude our topic.
