# What will we learn this term?

### **MATHS**



### **DECIMALS**

- We will represent numbers with up to 3 decimal places using counters and place value charts.
- We will round numbers with up to 3 decimal places to the nearest integer and tenth and hundredth.
- We will add and subtract numbers with different numbers of decimal places.
- We will multiply and divide numbers with up to 3 decimal places by 10, 100 and 1,000.

### **PERCENTAGES**

- We will use common factors to simplify fractions; use common multiples to express fractions in the same denomination
- We will recall and use equivalences between simple fractions, decimals and percentages, including in
- · We will solve problems involving the calculation of percentages and the use of percentages for comparison.

## **COMPUTING**



### SPREADSHEETS AND PROGRAMMING

This term we will continue to learn about spreadsheets. We will create charts, and evaluate their results in comparison to questions asked.

# **SCIENCE**

### **EVOLUTION & INHERITANCE**

We will recognise that living things produce offspring of the same kind, but normally offspring vary and are not identical to their parents.

We will recall that living things have changed over time and that fossils provide information about living things that inhabited the Earth millions of years ago.

We will identify how animals and plants are adapted to suit their environment in different ways and that adaptation may lead to evolution.



# P.E ATHLETICS

This term, we will be developing our existing running, jumping and throwing skills as well as learning new skills. by taking part in individual, paired and group activities and games.

### **ARABIC SPEAKING: COUNTRIES,** FOOD, DRINK AND PREFERENCES



In our Arabic lessons this term, we will cover many different topics. We will spend the first few weeks discussing and researching an Arabic speaking country, then creating a fact file including similarities and differences to the UK.

We will then learn breakfast, lunch and dinner items whilst being able to express our likes and dislikes. We will be able to construct simple and extended sentences with old and new vocabulary, and also have a simple conversation about the foods we eat and which foods are healthy and unhealthy.
