

Eco-Schools Curriculum Links

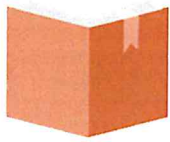
As you are aware our school is currently involved in Eco-Schools' Green Flag award programme. The Eco-Schools programme focuses on these ten topics:

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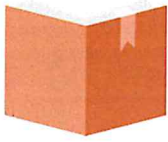
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Year Group: 5

Global citizenship	PSHE	Summer 1	Pupils learn about the British laws and the consequences of breaking the law.





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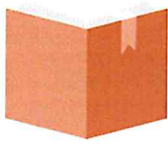
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Year Group: 6			
Topic	Subject	Term	Details

Biodiversity	Geography	Term 2	Year 7 studied the different biomes and explored the biosphere.





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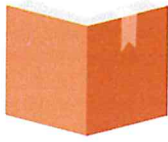
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Year Group: 8 + 9
